

**Hempfield School District
Wifi Hotspot Loaner Form**

Technology, and Internet access in particular, is frequently used in many courses at Hempfield and provides students with access to a wide range of educational resources. Hempfield is now offering wifi hotspots for students to borrow on a short term basis from high school and middle school libraries. These hotspots provide an education focused Internet connection for use in the completion of school assignments.

Parents/guardians must sign and agree to this usage policy prior to a student being permitted to borrow a hotspot. Please review these points with your child before signing. This permission form is valid for your student from the date signed going forward. If you wish to change the status of this permission form, please do so in writing to the school in which your student currently attends.

Hotspot Usage

1. All usage of the hotspot should be school related. Students must continue to abide by the district's Responsible Usage Policy (<http://start.students.hempfieldsd.org> under Policies) when using the hotspot at home.
2. The hotspot's Internet connection is filtered. However, no filter is perfect and it is acknowledged that some objectionable material may still be accessible.
 - YouTube and other high-bandwidth applications are not accessible.
3. Altering the hotspot's settings or configuration is strictly prohibited.
4. The district is not responsible for financial charges incurred by the student when using Internet based applications – i.e. iTunes purchases. The hotspot's data usage is paid for by the district.

Financial Responsibility

The student's family will become financially responsible for the hotspot in certain situations.

1. Areas of financial responsibility covered by the student's family:
 - Preventable damage from liquid, excessive heat, careless handling, or other foreseeable environmental threats.
 - Theft or loss resulting from inadequate security precautions - i.e. leaving the device in plain sight inside a parked car.
2. Areas of financial responsibility covered by the district:
 - Hardware problems that may occur during normal operation.
 - Theft of the device when adequate security measures have been taken - an official police report must be supplied.

The school office should be notified immediately in the event of any damage or theft.
